Neighborhood Watch Program Committee

We all help one another by keeping an eye on each other's homes and property. We each take it upon ourselves to keep each resident in our Area establish a telephone chain that enables neighbors to keep informed of criminal activity. We are also responsible for sending a representative to the annual meeting with the Sheriff's office to renew our Neighborhood Watch signs.

Luminary Committee

Welcome Committee

Social/Outreach Committee
